MICHIGAN "DID YOU KNOW" – A. HAAS HOUGHTON CONES By Randy Karasek

This article shows the three examples of the A.Haas cone tops from Houghton, Michigan, mainly to show some of the side panel details not visible with the USBC.



And finally we have USBC 168-10, a HP cone with an **IDENTICAL** design to the LP cone USBC 168-09. How can a squatter HP cone body share the exact design as a taller LP cone body? Look at the picture to the right. It really appears as if Haas simply used their LP sheets and cut them shorter to accommodate the taller HP cone spout! The HP is a tougher variation but looks more like poorly re-lidded LP cones!
